Reminders

- **WAGE INCREASE APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.** At the November 8 Board of Education meeting, the tentative agreements for both the AASD classified and AASD certificated units were presented for approval. The Board voted unanimously to approve the 3% increase (retroactive to July 1, 2016) and the January 1/February 1, 1% mid-year increase. Per the Agreement, the District has 90 days from the date of board approval to produce the retroactive checks. That would be by February 8, 2017.
 - **SAVE THE DATE! VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO ASSEMBLE "BIKES FOR KIDS" - SATURDAY DECEMBER 3, 2016.** "Bikes For Kids," a Charity Organization, has

been providing bikes to elementary kids for 14 years! This year, 600 bikes with helmets will be presented to all the 3rd graders at four SDUSD schools. (Depending on school size, the 2nd graders may be included!) To help support the surprise, recipient schools are kept a secret and will be revealed at a later date!

They need to be unpacked, assembled (it's pretty easy – a few nuts and bolts, air in the tires, etc.), and safety checked. No experience necessary! Bike assembly will start **Saturday morning, December 3, from 8:00am until they are done!** Pizza will be provided for motivation.
