AASD will recognize selected Distinguished Leaders in the categories listed below at the Annual Summerfest Event on Friday, **June 22, 2018**, at Marina Village. This year, the Distinguished Leader awards are sponsored by AASD and CALPRO.

The nominees for the Distinguished Leader Award must be a classified or certificated employee in a management or supervisory position or a retired member. Any member or retiree may nominate any member or retiree for this award (you do not have to limit your nomination to your specific job category). For example: A middle school principal may nominate a POS/BSS III or a Vice Principal may nominate a Food Services Supervisor, etc.

Nomination forms are due to the AASD Office by April 24. Please use the "Nominee Recommendation Form" to submit your nomination. Each candidate needs to have only one (1) Nominee Recommendation Form submitted to be considered for this award. A selection committee consisting of representatives from the Member Relations Committee will evaluate all nominations for the 2017-2018 Distinguished Leader Award.
