

AASD SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The AASD Scholarship is an award of \$1,000 which is given to any AASD Member in Good Standing, Retired Member, or Affiliate Member whose child (including stepchild) is a graduating senior this year and applies for the scholarship. The Member in Good Standing, Retired Member, or Affiliate Member's child must meet the minimum requirements below and plan to go on to post-secondary education within one year of graduation. AASD also supports our members' children who are non-diploma bound due to a disability. If the child is "promoting" and is going into an adult program they are eligible to apply for an AASD scholarship. Applicants who meet these conditions and who submit this application, along with the essay described below, will receive a scholarship.

Applications will be reviewed by the AASD Scholarship Committee and approved by the AASD Executive Board. Scholarships may be presented at the student's school awards/scholarship presentation event, if desired. If the AASD member/student does not wish to have the scholarship presented at their school event, the scholarship will be mailed to the AASD member's home address in June 2025.
